



Advisor Roles and Responsibilities

Recruitment and New Member Education Period

Advisors are no longer expected to attend all new member activities; however, the new requirements are listed below:

Recruitment:

- Advisors are expected to attend at least one (and as many as possible) events during the formal Recruitment Period for their respective Councils and Chapters. Example include: DGC Meet the Greeks, IFC and Panhellenic Formal/informal Recruitment period, NPHC Meet the Greeks!

New Member Education Period (Pledge, New Member Education, Intake periods)

- Organizations are now required to submit a calendar/ schedule of events to Fraternity and Sorority Life (F&SL) of their New Member Education period. The President and Advisor are required to sign off on the schedule and submit it to F&SL prior to the beginning of the New Member education process.
- Advisors are expected to set expectations for the new member education activities (including, but not limited to, non-hazing policies) to the new member class and current chapter members as it relates to Risk Management issues, specifically informing potential new members of their rights as it relates to the process. Advisors are to explain the University /Chapters expectations regarding appropriate behaviors and reinforce the values of the organization.
- Finally, advisors are required to attend at least 2 events, as determined by the calendar/schedule of events, without giving prior notice to the chapters to observe the new member education activities.
