We strive to recognize those who have attained a high standard of scholarship and leadership in interfraternal activities, to encourage them to continue along this line, and to inspire others to strive for similar conspicuous attainment.

Requirements:

- 1. Must be an active member of a Greek social organization for at least one semester
- 2. Ranked academically above the all-Greek system average (combined fraternity and sorority with a minimum 3.10 GPA (Spring 2019)
- 3. Currently a Junior or Senior standing
- 4. Completed at least one full academic year at the University of Central Florida
- 5. MUST attend General Body Meetings and participate in Order of Omega events

Partial or incomplete applications will NOT be accepted. All completed applications will be due **Friday**, **March 1**, **2019**.
