## Requirements:

- 2. Ranked academically above the all-Greek system average (combined fraternity and sorority with a minimum 3.11 GPA (Fall 2019)
- 3. Currently a Junior or Senior standing
- 4. Completed at least one full academic year at the University of Central Florida
- 5. MUST attend General Body Meetings and participate in Order of Omega events
