




Trick-or-Treat on Greek Street

SERF Process Reminders

- Any event that (1) includes alcohol, (2) takes place at a venue that serves alcohol, and/or (3) takes place 40 miles from Main Campus will require a SERF and Supplemental SERF 15 business days prior to the event.
- Events that require a SERF Submission will require pre-event and post-event meeting between a chapter representative and their <u>chapter coach</u> at minimum 15 business days before the event takes place. Be prepared to discuss logistics, sober monitors, registration requirements, and expectations.
- As of October 1, the SERF fine structure will be instituted
 - 15 business days prior to the event without penalty
 - Events submitted between 10 and 14 business days prior to the event will be subject to the following:
 - 1st offense: \$50, 2nd offense: \$100, 3rd offense: No additional events will be approved for the remainder of the semester
 - Events submitted less than 10 days prior to the event date will not be approved.

Party Themes and Costumes

Costumes

- Below are some helpful guidelines to help you decide on this year's costume!
 - Don't dress up as a culture or a race
 - Don't dress up as a mental illness or physical disability
 - Don't glorify rape or sexual assault
 - Don't be transphobic
 - Avoid controversial historical figures
- A costume is not consent to be touched or photographed

Party Themes

- Don't be dumb with event themes.
 - No misogyny, discrimination, or racism
 - Anything but clothes parties

A good rule to follow when planning activities is, "when in doubt, leave it out!"


